Terms and Conditions Of Sale

- 1. Sale to be held at the Scottsbluff County Fairgrounds in Mitchell Nebraska on April 9th , It will be a Silent Auction starting at 11 a.m. until 2 p.m. Final bids will be called for as we close each pen/ lot and last bidder will be the buyer.
- 2. Consigners need to check-in, weigh-in, and had their animals paint branded by 10:30 a.m. Please don't wait till the last minute!
- 3. Consigners are responsible for cleaning pens before and after sale, bedding and feed.
- 4. There is a \$10.00 per head consignment fee for each animal sold. \$ 5.00 goes to the Futurity and \$5.00 to WNSGA. Consigners can place a minimum bid to start the animal. \$10.00 per head sold will be deduced from you check which will be mailed out to sellers as soon as checks are cleared.

(In the past checks mailed about 7 working days after the sale.)

- 5. Every Animal sold will automatically be enrolled in the **Futurity**.
Payout premiums for 2011 as follows
 - a. Grand Champion \$50.00
 - b. Reserve Grand Champion \$25.00
 - c. Purple Ribbon \$12.00
 - d. Blue Ribbon \$8.00
 - e. Red Ribbon \$5.00

Paying out only one premium per animal, for their highest placement.

- 6. Purchasers are responsible for sending in their paper work after Fair/Shows to receive these Premiums by October 31st 2011.
- 7. There will be Door Prizes and Buyer Prizes awarded to the top high bidders
- 8. There will be a Vet in site to do paper work needed to transport animals out of state.
- 9. WNSGA does not encourage short docking on tails. WNSGA requires that castration includes both testicals, and all consigned animals must have **Scrapies Tags**
- 10. All consignors welcome but you must have current Membership in WNSGA.
- 11. Bidders / Buyers open to anyone. Not limited to 4H and FFA Buyers
- 12. AS per Fair rules club lambs and kids must be born on or after January 1st 2011. Breeding stock/Show stock please date as needed.
- 13. All consignments sold as **REGISTERED**, must have papers and transfers ready to transfer to buyer. Papers/ transfers will be mailed to buyer if paid by check. ***If you don't have papers ready on sale day they will sell as UNREGISTERED.***
- 14. Decorations, signs, curtains, tables, chairs or ???? anything you wish to use to promote the sale of your consignments is encouraged.
- 15. High Bidders are responsible for payment to WNSGA before purchase is removed. WNSGA accepts Good Checks and Cash. \$35.00 Charge for any return checks.
- 16. WNSGA is **NOT RESPONSIBLE** for any lose, injury , or accidents to anyone or thing in attendance.
